By forming a culture of equal rights and opportunities for women, the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan on "GENDER - GUARANTEES OF EQUAL RIGHTS AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR WOMEN AND MEN" was put into effect. The Senate approved this law on August 23, 2019, after being adopted by the Legislative Chamber on August 17, 2019.

Women are not only supported at Samarkand State University but required policy changes are also made. Our university is dedicated to creating a clean, safe, and healthy environment for all women.

Health Drives:

The University Advisory Council on Women's Issues and the Provincial "Healthy Generation" Fund organized a medical examination for the University's staff members, and during the event, certain essential items were distributed, including medications and other hygienic items for maintaining personal hygiene at the individual level.

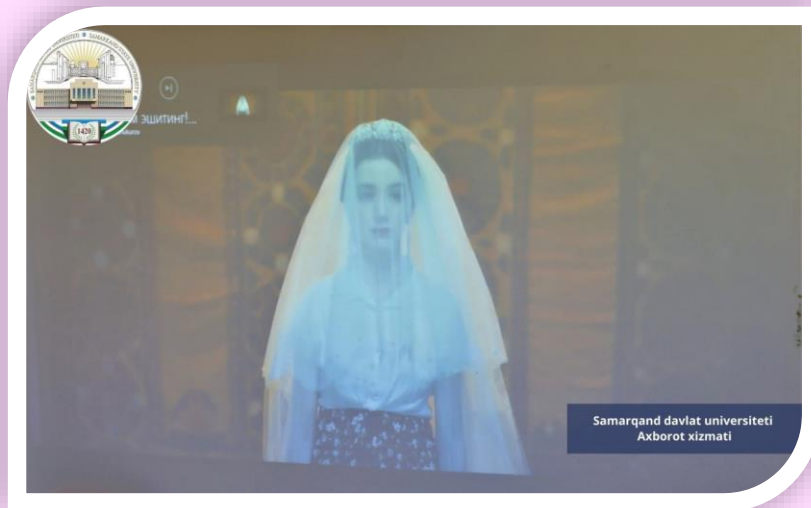
